

PHYSICIAN INFLUENCE PAVES THE WAY FOR PROVATION® APEX

From MEDITECH® Expanse to Provation's Cloud Solution

The healthcare industry is constantly evolving, and healthcare providers must adapt to these changes in order to provide the best possible care for their patients. In recent years, the focus has shifted towards the integration of cloud-based technology and software solutions to improve clinical efficiency from pre-procedure through post-procedure.

Broadlawns Medical Center® in Des Moines, Iowa recently reevaluated their gastroenterology (GI) procedure documentation solution. Physicians were documenting 1,200 GI procedures annually using electronic health record (EHR) system, MEDITECH Expanse.

Many healthcare organizations, including Broadlawns, are finding that EHR clinical modules are inefficient or incomplete when it comes to documenting specialty-specific procedures. EHRs do not usually come with content out of the box, so facilities are stuck building out and maintaining workflows. Coding is not usually automatically generated and applied to the procedure note, and image capture capabilities leave physicians wanting more.

The care team at Broadlawns looked to improve the quality of documentation, streamline the billing process, and enhance the overall patient experience with Provation.

PHYSICIANS PUSH FOR PROVATION

Jeanne Dobrzynski, Clinical Informatics Analyst at Broadlawns, has been with the hospital for more than 20 years. Prior to joining the IT department, she was an ER nurse for 10 years. She is self-described as "half-IT and half-clinical", making her the perfect fit to assist in the implementation of a new solution.

"Throughout the last few years, more than one physician requested that we switch to Provation," said Dobrzynski. TRAINING MADE FOR A SMOOTH IMPLEMENTATION

Provation Apex is equipped with online training assigned to clinical staff prior to implementation, so care teams can become familiar with the workflow prior to go-live. Niki Thompson, Broadlawns' Circulating Nurse, was in charge of training nurses on Provation Apex. She has been with Broadlawns for more than seven years.

"I went through all of the modules online before our go-live date. The trainings were incredibly helpful. Being able to do training virtually beforehand was really important because I knew what the solution was going to look like, and I could complete the training when I had time."

"As a Clinical Analyst, I work on a lot of implementations of varying sizes," said Dobrzynski. "This implementation was very smooth. I have found that sometimes I work on projects where the vendor doesn't seem to know exactly what is going on, but Provation had their act together. "The diagrams within Provation Apex's image management helps the coding team immensely," said Thompson. "Previously, there was a lot of back and forth between the coders and the surgeons. The coders would receive a note, but they would have to contact the physician for addendums on location and other details they missed. Provation Apex makes sure that all aspects of the procedure are documented. I don't think the coders have had to reach back out to physicians for edits since we implemented Provation Apex!"

Moreover, the software's user-friendly interface has resulted in a shorter learning curve for physicians and staff, ensuring that they can quickly become proficient in utilizing the software to its full potential. Templates, free text, and predictive entries are favorites of Broadlawns physicians.

"One of our doctors does anywhere between 9 and 13 scopes himself," said Dobrzynski. "He is becoming extremely efficient at documenting within Provation Apex. And at the end of these procedures, patient instructions are automatically generated for the patient with our discharge plans."
