The Migration Process

- 1



Agreement is Signed

 - Once the agreement is signed, we get started
 - Time needed to complete migration will vary based on the size of the data set, internet connection speed, and other factors
- 2



Kick-Off with Provation

 - Experienced Customer Success Advisors (CSAs) and Technical Advisors (TAs) will schedule a call with your team
 - Set expectations of scope, roles, and responsibilities
 - Discuss the project plan and timeline

Pre-"Go-Live" Migration

 - Provation will start migrating basic Operational Data shortly after signing
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Post-"Go-Live" Migration

 - Provation will migrate the remaining Operational Data and Reporting Data over to Provation Apex

 - ✗ Customs and Preferences

- ✗ Any logging or auditing data
 - ✗ Discrete data from Provation® MultiCaregiver
 - ✗ Videos
 - ✗ Ancillary documents
 - ✗ GIQuIC records
